Spring is right around the corner! We are getting excited about the summer and all the new items we will be adding to our Wayland summer events! Below is a list of the new items that you will see downtown.

Branding – We are in the final stages of a completed brand makeover for downtown Wayland! I am SOOO excited about the new colors and logo! Once this is finalized, we will share the logos for businesses to use along with the branding guide.

Mini-Tree Removal – In May we will be removing the current pine tree in the mini-park and replacing it with Red Cedar (smaller). We are working with our arborist to make sure this tree is taken care of every year. The reason behind the removal is the cost to decorate the tree and the bird waste. Because of the size of the tree, we could not hire a professional company to come and decorate it. We were also spending thousands each year on labor, rental, and lights. The new tree will be a fifth of the price! Plus, no bird poop on the seats and plaque (which is also getting replaced)!

 - June 16, 23, and 30 Comedy downtown. We are working with a comedy group to bring 3 nights of comedians downtown. Details are still being worked out.
 - July 12, 19, and 26 OpenRoad Brewery, McDuffs, and Hotel are hosting concerts in the streets. We will bring the stage downtown and close the streets for a night of music. Details on road closures will come over once the event is closer.
 - August 10, 17, and 24 Sidewalk Chalk days. We will close a block downtown and invite the residents to come downtown and draw on the streets. At 8 pm Movies After Dark will be in the park.
- WERC Committee
 - The WERC Committee will be sending out an email to our Main Street businesses about dog water bowls. If your business would like to have one, please let them know. We will provide the bowl; you will just be responsible to clean and keep the water full.

- Grow with Google April 12th from 9 am-2 pm we are hosting a workshop at BayPoint to teach businesses about how Google can help your business. Lunch will be provided.
 - This is part of a grant we received from Google. They provided the coach and funding for this year-long series! Make sure to check them out. I have attended a few and learned SO MUCH! Again, this is FREE to you thanks to a LARGE grant.

- Wayland Farmers Market
 - The Market is growing! We have moved the Farmers Market to Wayland City Park. This will be safer for residents, with more parking, bathrooms, and a larger space for growth!
 - We have hired a market manager to manage the market. Renee Wise has already done an amazing job! She has stepped up our advertising, and variety of vendors and we now accept EBT cards!

- o Summerfest 2023
 - We have been planning Summerfest for 2023. It will be moved to the second weekend in June (June 9th – 11th).
 - We have added SO MUCH to the lineup this year. Below are some items I would like to highlight.
 - Little Miss and Mister We are working with the 1st-3rd graders in the Wayland Union School district to select the first-ever Little Miss and Mister of Wayland. All the principals have been informed that every student has a chance to enter. The contest will be based on a drawing they do of "What does Wayland mean to me". The teachers, principals, and superintendent will all select (1) Miss and (1) Mister to be crowned for 2023.
 - Wildcat Color Run This color run will be FREE to all students. The students will run down Main Street on the morning of Summerfest. Friends and family will be able to have a color packet that will then be thrown on the kids as they run. The idea is to "prime" the streets for the day by creating a tie-dye look and also create a fun event for the family. I have tested these packets out and they wash out very easily.
 - Car Show The Car Show will be at Wayland City Park and will feature an Elvis tribute singer!
